

EXHIBITOR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Deadline is January 25, 2019

All exhibitors are required to submit a certificate of insurance (COI) or sign and submit the below Liability Waiver below.

If providing a certificate of insurance, the certificate must name US HUPO, Scientific Association Management and the Hilton Washington DC/Rockville, their respective directors, officers and employees as additional insureds. LIABILITY WAIVER

In lieu of a certificate of insurance, the following liability clause must be read and signed by all exhibitors in exhibit booths and vendor seminars.

Exhibitor agrees to protect, save and hold US HUPO and its officers, directors, employees and agents, Scientific Association Management, and the Hilton Washington DC/Rockville, and all agents and employees thereof (hereinafter collectively called Indemnities) forever harmless for any damage or charges imposed for violations of any law or ordinance, whether occasioned by the negligence of the exhibitors or those holding under the exhibitor, and further, the exhibitor shall, at all times, protect, indemnify, save and hold harmless the indemnities against and from any and all losses, costs, damages, liability or expenses (including attorney's fees) arising from or out of or by reason of any accident or bodily injury or other occurrences to any person or persons, including the exhibitor, its agents, employees or business invitees, which arise from or out of or by reason of said exhibitor's occupancy and use of the exhibition premises.
