Dr. Dabke earned her PhD in Biomedical Sciences from Cedars-Sinai Medical Center mentored by Dr. Michelle Jones and Dr. Sarah Parker. Her doctoral work involved analysis of proteomics data to study disease progression and recurrence of high grade serous ovarian cancer.
